DAY 8	 Join lessons and activities at a local school Cruise along the Sumida River for views of Tokyo's skyline
DAY 9	 Take in panoramic views from the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building Visit Tokyo Character Street for anime & pop culture shopping Celebratory dinner

Meals in Japan typically feature rice, noodles, vegetables, and fresh seafood, with flavors that balance savory umami and delicate seasonings. You'll enjoy a variety of traditional dishes alongside familiar options to keep everyone comfortable.

CLIMATE

Japan experiences four distinct seasons, with mild to warm temperatures in spring and autumn, hot and humid summers, and cold winters. Rainfall is moderate yearround, with occasional typhoons in late summer, so it's best to be prepared for changing weather no matter when you visit.
